EMERGENCY CHARGES FOR SURGERIES

What is an 'Emergency Hours Charge' and how it is calculated ?

Emergency rate @ 1.5 times the regular charge will be applicable in the following instances

Surgery performed outside regular working hours of the O.T

- Surgeries started after 6pm on Working Days will be treated as emergency cases and shall be charged @1.5 times the standard rate on Operation Theatre, Hospital Anaesthesia, Surgeon Fees and Anaesthetist Fees.
- Surgeries started before 6pm but continued beyond 6pm will be treated as emergency cases & shall be charged @1.5 times the standard rate on Operation Theatre & Hospital Anaesthesia. Surgeries performed at any time on Sundays or Public holidays will be treated as emergency cases and shall be charged @1.5 times the standard rate on Operation Theatre, Hospital Anaesthesia, Surgeon Fees and Anaesthetist Fees.

Surgery performed without prior booking / late booking

- Surgeries performed without prior booking of a slot by the Surgeon will be treated as emergency cases and shall be charged @1.5 times the standard rate on Operation Theatre and Hospital Anaesthesia.
- Bookings for surgeries should be received before 12 noon minimum one working day prior to the scheduled date of surgery. Surgeries booked after the cut-off time for theatre booking will be treated as emergency cases and shall be charged @1.5 times the standard rate on Operation Theatre and Hospital Anaesthesia.

Note : If the OT could not be booked in advance due to valid reasons (e.g casualty cases), then Professional Fees will be charged as per emergency rate upon instruction from the concerned Surgeon.

Surgery performed outside the allotted slot time

- Surgeries which continue beyond the allotted slot timings will be treated as emergency cases and shall be charged @1.5 times the standard rate on Operation Theatre, Hospital Anaesthesia and Anaesthetist Fees. For example if a two-hour slot is booked for a Grade 1 surgery, but the surgery continues upto three hours, emergency rate will be applicable proportionately for one hour.
- Surgeries re-scheduled outside the allotted slot time will be treated as emergency cases and shall be charged @1.5 times the standard rate on Operation Theatre and Hospital Anaesthesia. For example, if the surgery is booked from 10 am - 1 pm but the case is performed from 12 noon - 3 pm, emergency rate will be applicable proportionately for two hours, viz. from 1pm - 3pm.

Please Note

- Emergency charge will be levied on Operation Theatre Charges and Anaesthesia charges based on the total time taken for surgery (i.e on Standard Hours + Additional Hours).
- If surgery time exceeds the Standard Hours and is performed outside working hours of the Operation Theatre, then both additional hours and emergency hours charges will be applicable.

MULTIPLE SURGERIES:

How will the patient be charged if more than one surgery is performed at a time ?

- If more than one surgery is performed during the same session, i.e. within a single theatre slot, hospital charges will be applied only once for the benefit of the patient. Grading of multiple surgeries will be determined by the hospital management & will generally be one grade higher than the grades of the respective surgeries. Doctors' Fees will be applicable separately for each surgery.
- If more than one surgery is performed during different sessions (i.e. at different slots during the same day or on different days) the charges for each surgery will be levied separately.

- All Foreign National / NRI / PIO and OCI patients are requested to submit copy of Patients Passport, Visa / PIO and OCI before admission.
- Minimum class permissible for Foreign National / NRI / PIO and OCI patients is Twin Sharing.
- If daycare patient requires indoor admission, the minimum class applicable would be Twin sharing.
- Upgradation from lower class to higher class, all charges of the higher class will be applicable from the date of admission.

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Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) regarding Surgery Charges

Given below are some of the frequently asked questions related to surgical charges along with guidelines to help you estimate the cost of surgery. Please speak to your Admitting Doctor or surgeon immediately to seek further guidance and to work out a comprehensive estimate of charges.

How much will the surgery cost ?

Charges for surgery are based on the following factors :

- 'Grade' of the Surgery
- Whether the surgery was planned (i.e. with prior booking of a slot in the Operation Theatre) or it was conducted on an emergency basis.
- Class occupied by the patient (i.e. Common, Twin Sharing, etc.)

Based on the above, the patient is billed under the following heads :

- Operation Theatre Charges
- Anaesthesia Charges
- Surgeon Fees
(More than one surgeon may be present in case of complicated / multiple surgeries).
- Anaesthetist Fees
- Medicines and Materials used during the surgery.

Please note that certain consumables and medicines used during the surgery can be quite expensive. It is advisable to enquire with your Surgeon whether any such items will be applicable in your case.

How is the Grade of surgery determined ?

Each surgery is assigned a 'Grade' based on a number of factors including complexity of the surgery, expected duration, etc. Your Admitting Doctor or Surgeon will be able to inform you about the grade of surgery applicable in your case prior to the surgery.
