

Spina Bifida cases a major public health challenge in Maha & India

Mumbai, Jan 12 (UNI) India Spina bifida cases have become a major public health burden in Maharashtra and across India, with an alarming 4-5 cases reported per 1000 live births and the Department of Pediatric Surgery along with the Spina Bifida Foundation, is organizing a free multidisciplinary counselling and program in Lilavati Hospital on Tuesday 30th January.

Spina Bifida is a congenital birth defect that happens when a baby is growing inside the mother. It happens when the spinal cord, brain, or their covering called meninges don't grow properly.
